
Cherry Hill Board of Fire Commissioners Agenda

- A/C Baum reported that he has spoken with the Insurance Service Organization to discuss 10 areas of concern that will be reevaluated.
- Fire Chief Kolbe reported that a graduation ceremony was held for the 14 EMT graduates. A/C Baum attended the event which was held at Central Command.
- Fire Chief Kolbe stated that meetings have been held with the new officers of the Church Road Civic Association as they transition into their new roles.
- B/C McGeady reported that the Rescue Apparatus Committee is completing their design work and will be submitting their report and recommendations to the Office of The Fire Chief. B/C McGeady also reported that the FOAP training is underway and that he will be attending the National Fire Academy for a two week training course.
- EMS Lt. Allen reported on the current EMS response statistics. Currently, the EMS units are over 100 more calls for service that last year at this time.
