2. Complete a brief statement on the 2025 proposed Annual Budget and make comparison to the 2024 adopted budget.

Despite the absence of any appropriations for Capital purchases, the Cherry Hill Fire District budget increased 1.5% in 2025. (Had there been an appropriation for Capital items as the same level as in 2024 (\$1.4MM) , the increase from year-to year would have been approximately 6%.) The increases from 2024 were driven by increases in payroll, healthcare and training expenses. Payroll expenses increased due to the addition of 2 firefighter positions as well as increases in fire fighter and fire officer salaries. Increases in firefighter and fire officer salaries reflect the newly negotiated contract for those members. Increases in healthcare costs for active and retired members were primarily driven by increases in health insurance premiums with the State Health benefit plans and the addition of new retirees. Increases in training and related expenses reflect the plan to conduct a training academy during 2025 to add new members and replace recently retired members

Page F-2: The use of Unrestricted Fund Balance as a source of revenue decreased due to the absence of any Capital purchases needed in 2025. Total Operating Grant Revenue decreased \$38,000 due to the exclusion of the Camden County Fire watch grant . The grant may be reinstated at some point during 2025 but as of December 17th, no formal agreements have been executed.

Page F-3 (Detail 2): Supplies increases \$55K (10.1%) reflecting additional appropriations for PPE and Uniforms needed for the Training Academy for new recruits planned for 2025. Training expenses increased \$100K (58%) for expenses likewise related to the Fire Academy (including, but not limited to transportation expenses, bringing in outside instructors and renting of offsite training facilities). Paramedic certifications decreased by \$14,700 due to 3 members choosing to let their certifications lapse and one member, who had the certification, resigning. Both Firefighter and EMT overtime were increased by \$200,000 to more accurately reflect the actual expenses incurred in these accounts each year. Increases in Maintenance Repairs of \$285K were primarily due to an increase of \$239K in Motor Maintenance expenses. Increases in Motor Maintenance expenses are anticipated because of the aging fleet of vehicles and the increased usage of the fleet over the past several years, Profession Maintenance expenses were also increased by \$46K in 2025 for planned upgrades to facilities.

This year's budget calls for a 7% increase in the amount to be raised by taxation. The increase is necessary to continue the district's reliance on unrestricted fund balance and to better match current year appropriations to the amount to be raised by taxation. With the exception of 2024, the amount to be raised by taxation has remained relatively flat for the past 10 years. This year's increase will exceed the Tax Levy Cap but will be funded in part by previous years CAP bank. Unrestricted Fund Balance is again expected to be reduced by 41% due to the increased costs of healthcare, salaries, training and motor maintenance expenses. However the CHFD is expected to maintain an Unrestricted Fund Balance of at least \$2.8MM for 2025. As there are no large capital purchases planned for 2026 this should not have an impact on next year's budget.

The ATBR of \$27,938,205 exceeds the maximum ABTR of \$27,471,760 by \$466,445.00. However the Cherry Hill Fire Department will avail themselves of Cap Bank Available from 2022 and Cap Bank available from 2023.
